Software Upgrade

We are currently changing our current software to a more efficient and effective system in order to serve you better. We would like to implore you to bear with us as we go through this upgrade.

Utility Billing: From Minimum to Estimate billing

Effective August 2014, the town will be adopting estimate billing instead of minimum billing system. This will help bridge the gap between the months when an estimate is done and the actual reading and bill is generated.

Extra Garbage/Recycle Bins

Extra Garbage and Recycle Bins are available. Cost is \$10/month.

Crosswalks & Solid Yellow Line

As summer is in full gear, drivers are urged to be courteous to other road users and stop at crosswalks for pedestrians specially seniors and children in order to avoid accidents. Drivers are also warned not to cross solid yellow lines on Main Street to angle park as our bylaw officer will be handing out fines to offenders.

Bylaw Tidbits

Please be courteous of your neighbors and keep your yards neat and your unhitched boats and trailers off of the streets. Owners of boats & trailers get a 48hrs grace after arrival and if not moved, it contravenes our bylaws and could result in a visit from our bylaw officer.

Leaves and grass clippings placed in approved biodegradable or compostable bags will be picked up every Tuesday, dependent on the weather. Bags are available at the town office for \$1.00/bag plus GST. They are also available at Home Hardware and various locations in Prince Albert.

Driveway Paving

When the paving crew is through, they will have some time to pave driveways. The estimated cost will be \$45/m²
