

Snowmobilers (dated for an ad for the Chronicle, November 30, 1998)

The following regulations apply to snowmobiling in the Town of Shellbrook:

1. It is not lawful to operate any snowmobile on Main Street from the CN Station to 5th Avenue, or Second Avenue West from Main Street to Second Street West, or on any Provincial Highway. It is, however, lawful to cross any of these right of ways in a perpendicular manner.
2. Subject to Section 1, the operations of Snowmobiles in the Town of Shellbrook shall only be permitted where the snowmobile is driven in the most direct route from one point to another in the Town of Shellbrook or in the most direct route out of Town.
3. No person shall drive a snowmobile on private property without the consent of the owner, or on any school grounds, hospital grounds, park areas, playgrounds, golf course, or airstrip.
4. Violation of these regulations can result in fines of up to \$250.00
