The Victim Services Unit is a program working in conjunction with Sask. Justice and the RCMP to support anyone who has suffered harm including **physical injury, economic loss or emotional suffering as a result of a crime or traumatic event.**

The region encompasses the areas of **Big River, Spiritwood, Shellbrook and Prince Albert Rural** communities.

The services the unit provides include (but are not limited to) the following:

- **Victim's Services**
- **Crisis Intervention- On and Off- Scene**
- **Emergency Intervention Orders**
- **Aboriginal Resources**
- **Victim Impact Statement Program**
- **Victim/Witness Programs which include court orientation, transportation, accompaniment and support**
- **Alternative Measures Accompaniment**
- **Surrogate Victim**
- **Assistance with Victim's Compensation/Restitution**
- **On scene, home or office visits**
- **Referrals to other agencies/Specialized programs**
- **Provide Information**
- **Court updates**
- **Community liaison**
